

Transition Requirements

- **E-8/E-9 will convert in Oct 01 (Grand fathered)**
- **Soldiers who are NREMT-I /P**
 - **91W MOS Awarded 1 Oct 01**
- **Soldiers with Valid NREMT-B Certificate**
- **BTLS or PHTLS + Trauma-AIMS (If required)**
- **Soldiers with a Valid LPN License and a BNCOC Graduate (After 1 Oct 96)**
- **NREMT + BTLS or PHTLS**



Transition Requirements

- **All others will require:**



and

BTLS or PHTLS (advanced provider courses)

and

Trauma-AIMS

 - 24 hours
- Media
 - Video Tele Training
- Requirements
 - Current BLS certification
 - Current or no more than 2 years lapsed NREMT certification

 - 91B or 91C with more than 2 years lapsed NREMT certification
 - 91B or 91C with EMT knowledge and skills
- Course of Action
 - EMT-B Bridge Course

 - Current BLS certification
 - Pre-test

 - Full NREMT-B Course
- Length
 - 110 hours
- Requirements
 - Current BLS certification

NREMT-B COURSE

- Option A
 - 10 weekends
- Option B
 - 21 days AT/ADT
- Option C
 - 4 weekends + 1 week AT/ADT

Trauma AIMS

- 68 Hours Advanced EMS Skills Course
- Must have NREMT-B
- BTLS/PHTLS not required
- Integrated course

•91C and BNOC graduates after October 96 do not need to take Trauma AIMS

PRE-HOSPITAL TRAUMA LIFE SUPPORT (PHTLS)

- Scenario
 - All 91B and 91C
- Length
 - 21-24 hours (average)
- Requirements
 - Current BLS certification
 - Current EMT-B certification




PHTLS ADVANCED PROVIDER COURSE

- **21 / 24 hours**
- **Option**
- **1 Week-end**

Action Plan Full Course for completing all requirements

- NREMT
- 10 Week-ends IDT
- 15 days ADT
- Will include Trauma AIMS and PHTLS
- To accelerate transition in one year. This assumes that soldiers need all three courses to have the MOS awarded.

Medical Force Readiness

- **91W reflects combat developers “*Future Medic*”**
 - Aligns with Joint Vision 2020
- **AC/RC integration of training to one standard**
 - National Registry Emergency Medical Technician Certification (NREMT-B)
- **91W will meet the operational requirements of the future**
 - Emergency Care
 - Limited Primary Care
 - Force Medical Protection
 - Evacuation and Retrieval
